1. **Misson Sundarban:** This was our first project. We were able to reach the area of Sundarban on 17th March, 2019 and contributed clothes, new or old (but in good condition), among less privileged people and distribute exercise books, pens, pencils, geometry boxes, rubbers, sharpner among hundred children of Chargheri Primary School, Vill+P.O.- Chargheri, P.S.- Gosaba, South 24 Parganas and Dakhintala Primary School Number 21, Vill- Sonagan, P.O.- Dulki, South 24 Parganas, Gosaba 743370. 2. **Universal Smile:** In our second project, we went to an orphan organization named "Universal Smile" which is situated at 147/74 Picnic Garden Road, Kolkata 700039 on 30th March, 2019 and distributed some food items like rice, pulses, soyabean, biscuits packets among the resident children so that they can use it for the next thirty days. 

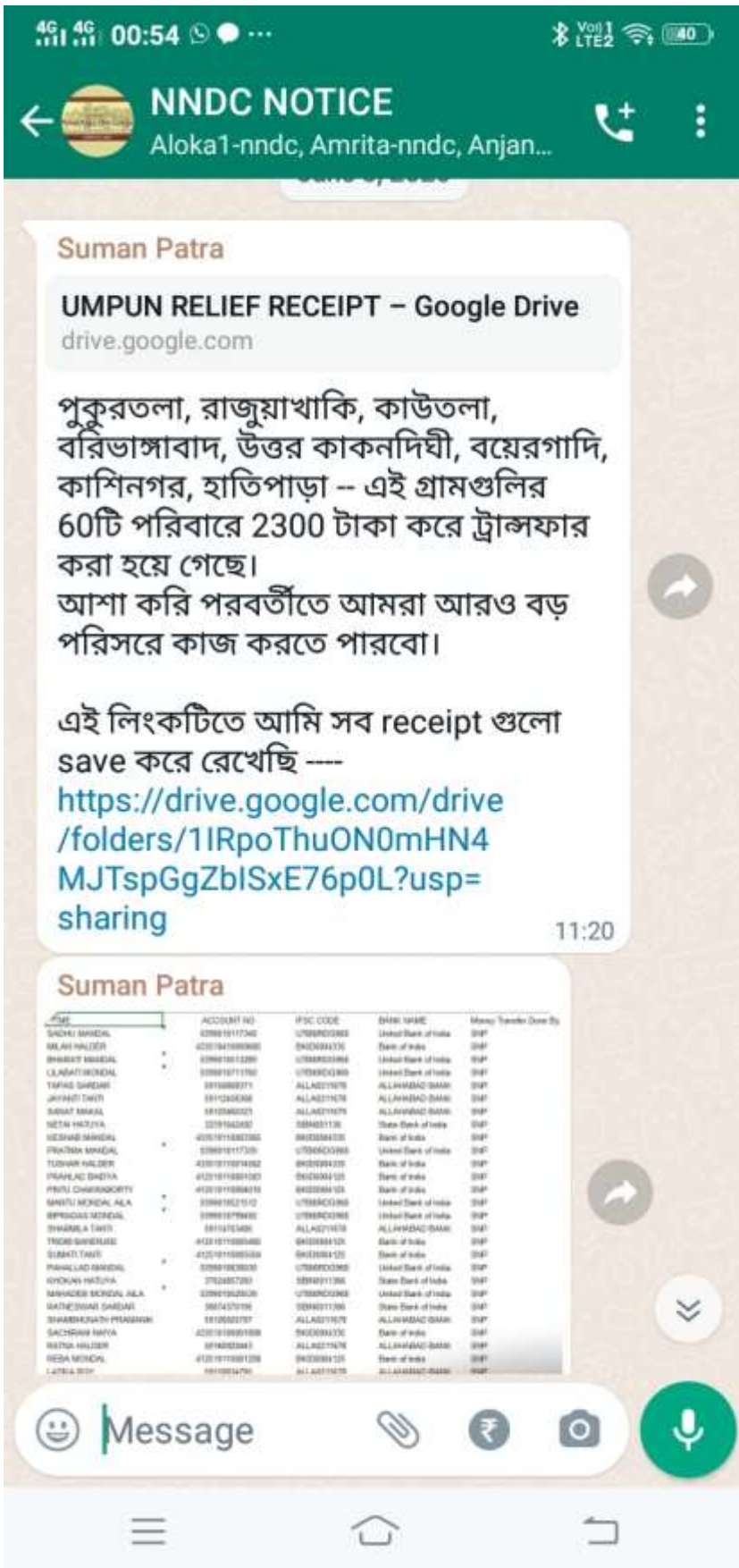

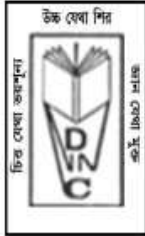
