

Extension Activities from 2017 - 2022

Blood Donation Camp: The college arranged Blood Donation Camp in 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2021. The Students Union plays active role in organising these camps. In 2017, 2018 and 2019 blood donation camps were in association with M. R. Bangur Hospital.

Students, non-teaching and teaching staff take part in this programme enthusiastically. In 2017, 19 teachers and 154 students donated blood. In 2018, 18 teachers and 125 students donated blood. In 2019, 23 teachers and 110 students donated blood.



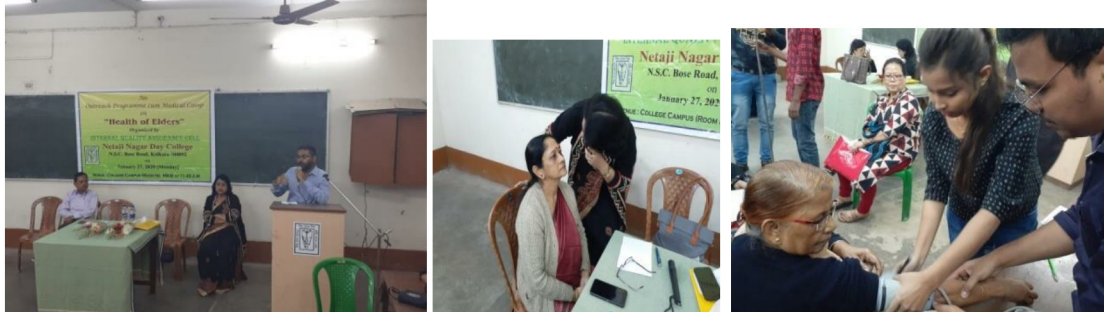
In 2021, Blood Donation Camp was in association with Department of Health, West Bengal Government. To maintain covid protocol, a mobile van was arranged. 18 teachers and 112 students donated blood. In 2022, Blood donation camp 17 teachers and 110 students donated blood.



Prevention of Dengue: On 12th October, 2018 Department of Zoology in association with Kolkata Municipal Corporation organised an awareness programme in the ward no. 98. 153 students participated under the leadership of one departmental teacher. Around 80 people of the ward participated in the awareness programme. On 31.08. 2019, another dengue prevention camp was arranged. 85 people participated in the programme.



An outreach program-cum-medical camp on 'Health of Elders': On 27th January, 2020 the camp for elders was arranged by IQAC, NNDC. An eminent Eye specialist, Dr. Mahua Mazumder delivered lecture on 'Common Eye Ailments'. A well-known dental surgeon Dr. Mayukh Chakraborty delivered lecture on 'Dental Hygiene'. Both doctors examined aged persons of the locality and our college. 87 people participated in the programme.



Awareness Programme on ill effects of Tobacco consumption: Blue line campaign: On 19th February, 2020 the college organised an outreach programme on ill effects of tobacco consumption in association with NGO MANT. 10 teachers and 165 students participated in the programme. A rally was organised in the surrounding area of the college to make people aware.



Awareness Programme and Thalassemia Carrier detection camp:

The college has organised a Thalassemia carrier detection camp on 26th February, 2020, in association with Kolkata Medical College, Institute of Haematology and Transfusion Medicine. NSS units of this college played an active role to arrange it. The purpose of this camp was to educate students and raise awareness about the disease and carriers. 114 persons (students and college staff) participated. 100 persons were normal, 14 were detected as carrier. The identity of the carriers is not disclosed publicly at the same time counselling is done confidentially by doctors in presence of their guardians.

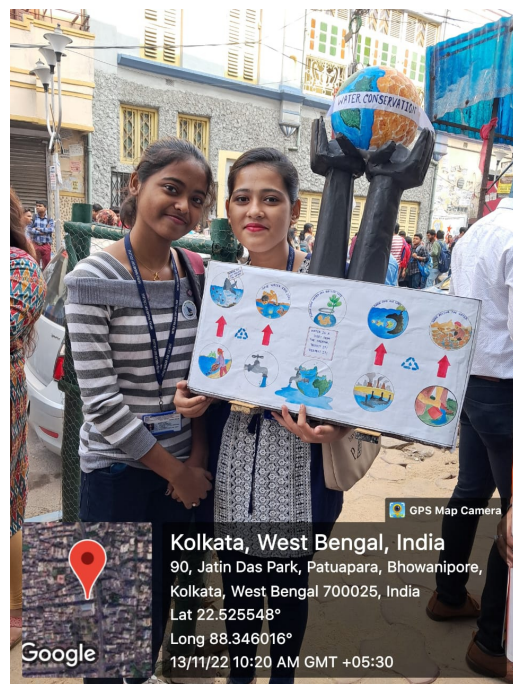

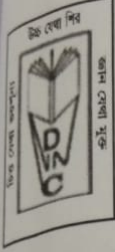
